## ***Lirip 2 "Banyuhay: Ang Multikultural na Edukasyon Tungo sa Transpormatibong Lipunan"***

Responding to the challenge of disseminating new knowledge towards the advancement of the Filipino language, Lumina Foundation for Integral Human Development, Inc. in collaboration with the Network of Professional Researchers and Educators, Inc. held the national conference on Filipino dubbed *Lirip 2 "Banyuhay: Ang Multikultural na Edukasyon Tungo sa Transpormatibong Lipunan"* last Oct 28-30, 2018 at Hue Hotel, Puerto Princesa, Palawan.

LIRIP is a Filipino word meaning "reflection on truth." The research congress provided an innovative and comprehensive overview of the latest research in teaching and learning using the Filipino language. It also explored the various ways in which the Filipino language have positively influenced and shaped the lives of educators and learners. The research congress was attended by 44 scholars from different educational institutions.

## NPRE Community Engagement

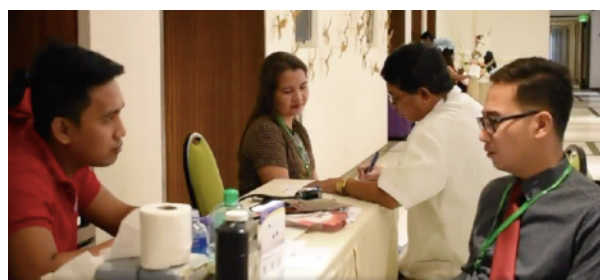
### LUMINA FOUNDATION BLOOD DRIVE
